## JTSA – submitting to QFFE special issue

This is a brief summary. You should also refer to the JTSA general **author guidelines** before submitting:

**Authorship:** we request that no one author should appear on more than one paper in a special issue. Please discuss initially with the guest editor(s) of the issue, if this poses a problem.

**Length restriction**: we expect your special issue paper to be up to 30 pages in length, and it should not exceed 35 pages. Note that supporting information (outside this limit) can be provided separately and will be posted online with the published paper (e.g. appendices, proofs, code, additional figures and tables).

**File formats**: JTSA does not require the use of a template for file submission. The formats most commonly used by authors are LaTeX and Word. If using LaTeX, you will be required to upload a PDF version as well, which will be used for the review process.

Submission of all new papers to JTSA is now via the Wiley **Research Exchange** (ReX) submission portal:

This makes the submission process faster and easier for authors. It does not replace but links with the existing JTSA ScholarOne site: <a href="https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/jtsa">https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/jtsa</a>

When you submit your paper via the ReX site, it is important that you indicate that the paper is for a special issue:

Please choose 'Special Issue Article' as the manuscript type.

Also, you will be asked to choose the name of the special issue from a drop-down list, in this case:

"Time Series for QFFE"
